

**City of Northville
Liquor License Review Committee
June 6, 2016**

Call to Order

A meeting of the Liquor License Review Committee was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the City of Northville Municipal Building, City Council Chambers, 215 West Main Street, Northville, Michigan, 48167.

It was noted that Mayor Pro Tem James Allen, Councilmember Marilyn Price, and Member John Buckland were present.

Also present were City Clerk Dianne Massa, Police Chief Michael Carlson, City Manager Patrick Sullivan, and representatives from Genitti's, Inc. No citizens were present.

Approval of Agenda

No changes to the agenda were made.

Approval of Minutes

Motion Price, seconded by Buckland to approve the January 19, 2016 minutes as presented.
Motion carried unanimously.

Request to Transfer Shares of Stock Interest / Genitti's Inc.

Genittis, Inc., dba Genitti's Hole-In-The-Wall, located at 108 - 110 E. Main Street, owned by Antonia Genitti, has dropped John Genitti, Jr. as a stockholder. Antonia Genitti requested, through the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC), transfer of 600 of the 1000 shares of stock interest to Laura Genitti. Laura Genitti, Antonia's daughter, has managed the business for 15 of the 45 years they have been in business.

Laura Genitti has submitted a Plan of Operation, which indicates the restaurant will be open Monday through Thursday 9:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m., and Friday through Sunday 9:00 a.m. - 11:30 p.m., subject to change at customers' request. Laura Genitti stated that the Plan of Operation reflects the way they have conducted business for the past 45 years and she does not anticipate any changes in the future. Genitti's Restaurant has a capacity of 250 people with four dining

rooms and 75% of the business is food sales, with 25% being alcohol. A check on the history of the business shows one MLCC violation in 2009. The Department has conducted a background check on the owners and has found no negative contacts prohibiting the transfer.

It was noted that all fees and costs have been paid by the applicant. Staff does not find a reason to object to the transfer request.

Public hearing opened at 7:03 p.m. No comments. Public hearing closed at 7:03 p.m.

Motion Price, seconded by Buckland to recommend that City Council approve the Plan of Operation and take no action to object to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission approving the request by Genitti's, Inc. to transfer interest in the Class C Resort and SDM License to Laura Genitti. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Discussion

It was noted that N. Center Brewing submitted an application for a small winemaker's license and an outdoor service permit. The Police Chief is waiting for the applicant to submit additional information before bringing the request to the LLRC.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:04 p.m.
